NOTICE OF SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR 2025-2026

[Issued pursuant to Section 115.7915(5)(a) of the state statutes]

This notice serves to inform parents and guardians of students with disabilities that the State of Wisconsin has established the Special Needs Scholarship Program. Under this scholarship program, a child with a disability may be eligible to receive a scholarship from the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) that allows the child to attend a private school that is participating in the scholarship program.

A parent or guardian who is interested in the Special Needs Scholarship Program should independently verify the participating private schools and the specific terms, eligibility criteria, and application procedures of the scholarship program with the DPI. To be eligible for a scholarship, the child must be a resident of the state and have an individualized education program (IEP) or services plan in effect.

Parents and guardians of students new to the Special Needs Scholarship Program may apply to the program beginning July 1, 2025, and throughout the course of the 2025-2026 school year. Eligible students who currently participate in the Special Needs Scholarship Program will not have to re-apply or submit annual applications to be eligible for a scholarship.

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AVISO DEL PROGRAMA DE BECAS PARA NECESIDADES ESPECIALES 2025-2026

Este aviso informa a los padres y tutores de estudiantes con discapacidad que el Estado de Wisconsin ha establecido el Programa de Becas para Necesidades Especiales. Bajo este programa, un niño con discapacidad puede ser elegible para recibir una beca del Departamento de Instrucción Pública (DPI) que le permita asistir a una escuela privada participante.

Los padres o tutores interesados en el Programa de Becas para Necesidades Especiales deben verificar de forma independiente con el DPI las escuelas privadas participantes, así como los términos, criterios de elegibilidad y procedimientos de solicitud. Para ser elegible para una beca, el niño debe ser residente del estado y contar con un programa educativo individualizado (IEP) o un plan de servicios vigente.

Los padres y tutores de estudiantes nuevos en el Programa de Becas para Necesidades Especiales pueden solicitar su ingreso a partir del 1 de julio de 2025 y durante el año escolar 2025-2026. Los estudiantes elegibles que actualmente participan en el Programa de Becas para Necesidades Especiales no tendrán que volver a solicitar la beca ni presentar solicitudes anuales para ser elegibles.
