Dear Parents/Guardians,

Education, like many other professions today, is experiencing a shortage of workers. This shortage includes teachers, food service and classroom aide positions.

Our schools have been able to operate despite these shortages, but with your help, we can improve our services. We are asking parents/guardians and community members to consider helping with staff shortages. If you are willing to help, we can work with you to accommodate a flexible schedule.

Teaching Opportunities: Did you know to become a substitute teacher you only need to have a minimum of a 2-year degree? The daily rate would be no less than \$135 per day. You could work full or part days.

Food Service Opportunities: These positions require a high school diploma or general education degree (GED). You assist with quality food preparation and cleaning of the kitchen and equipment. The hourly rate is no less than \$14.20 per hour.

Classroom Aide Opportunities: These positions require a high school diploma or general education degree (GED). You work directly with students and teachers to provide assistance with academic and/or behavioral needs. The hourly rate is no less than \$14.45 per hour.
