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Course Descriptions

<u>ART ACADEMY</u> - Demonstrate your creativity through finger paints, water colors, perler beads and glitter. We will use fine motor skills to produce high quality and creative work. <u>Fee = \$10.00</u>

ART DESIGN - Do you like to scrapbook, build paper sculptures, craft with yarn, and paint? Then this class is for you. Students will also dabble with technology like Pixel Art and BeFunky Photo Editor. **FEE-\$10.00**

<u>BACKYARD GAMES</u> – Stay active by enjoying the games we love to play in our backyard, picnics and family events. Ring toss, Cornhole, 4 Square, Mini-golf, Jenga and Yard Yahtzee to name a few. We will also work on good sportsmanship and social skills as we explore a variety of recreational games. *NO FEE*

<u>DIGGING UP DINOSAURS</u> - A "hands-on" science program. In this course we will be "digging up" information about dinosaurs while participating in fun activities. We will be reading books, writing, playing games, making fossils, singing songs and measuring the size of dinosaurs for comparison. <u>Fee = \$10.00</u>

EXACT PATH - Keep moving forward with Math and Reading skill mastery. Exact Path is a self-paced program that may be completed at anytime, from anywhere with internet access. A school computer is available for the summer to make working on the program more accessible. This individualized program works on specific skill readiness and provides instruction within your child's learning path. <u>GAMESMANSHIP</u> - Students will play games that stress being cooperative and promote gamesmanship. KINDERGARTEN MATH (Entering KG) - This course will expand math readiness through activities, games and projects. NO FEE

<u>KINDERGARTEN READING</u> (Entering KG) - This course is open to incoming Kindergarten students. Students will expand reading readiness through Rhyming Word Bingo, Reading Round Up and Sight Word Slap. <u>NO FEE</u>

<u>MARCHING, JAZZ BAND</u> Open to students entering 7th and 8th grades that have at least one year of experience on his/her instrument. All instruments welcome. Students must secure an instrument prior to the start of class. This course features a mix of marching band, pep band and jazz band experiences. Students prepare for upcoming parades in the fall, and learn the basics of pep and jazz band styles. This is a great way for students to experiment with a variety of musical genres while having fun in a relaxed, informal summertime setting. <u>NO FEE</u>
