

## Student Protocol for Positive Family Member in the Household

Isolation Ability	If the COVID-19 positive family member in the household <u><i>can isolate</i></u> from other household members	If the COVID-19 positive family member in the household <u><i>can not isolate</i></u> from other household members
Quarantine Procedure Used	<p><b>Quarantine Length:</b> Quarantine for 10 days from the last day of contact with the positive family member.</p> <p><b>Return to School Date:</b> Household family members may return to school on day #11 if they are symptom-free.</p>	<p><b>Quarantine Length:</b> Quarantine for 20 days from last contact with the positive family member.</p> <p>*Per Washington/Ozaukee Public Health recommendations, the student's quarantine would include the 10 days the positive family member is quarantined plus 10 more days after.</p>
Early Return to School Option	<p><b>Early return to school option:</b> Students who are not COVID-19 positive may test at day #6 from the last contact with the positive family member. If COVID-19 negative, they may return to school early if symptom-free.</p>	<p><b>Early return to school option:</b> Students who are not COVID-19 positive may test at day #16 from last contact with the positive family member. If COVID-19 negative, they may return to school early if symptom-free.</p>

*If there is a close contact within a student's household, specific quarantine requirements of the individual will be determined on a case-by-case basis.*
